In consideration of SDB Bank PLC, (hereinafter referred to as “the Bank”), opening of **SDB Dayada** Account of (Child’s name- hereinafter referred to as “the said minor”), I hereby undertake to make the agreed deposit at once as stated above.

It is agreed that the bank shall undertake to pay the face value of the certificate Rupees.....(Rs.....) (Subject to taxes if any), to the said minor only upon reaching the age of 18 years. If there’s a discrepancy in the given date of birth with the birth certificate, face value calculated based on the false information will be adjusted at the time of payment.

It is further agreed that no withdrawals would be permitted until the said minor reaches the age of 18 years.

In the event of the Minor’s death prior to reaching the age of eighteen years, the Law of Succession of Sri Lanka will be applicable at the time of claiming the **SDB Dayada (Lump sum)** account. In such case applicable rate or rates as may be decided at the discretion of the Bank.
